Parade: NO REPORT.

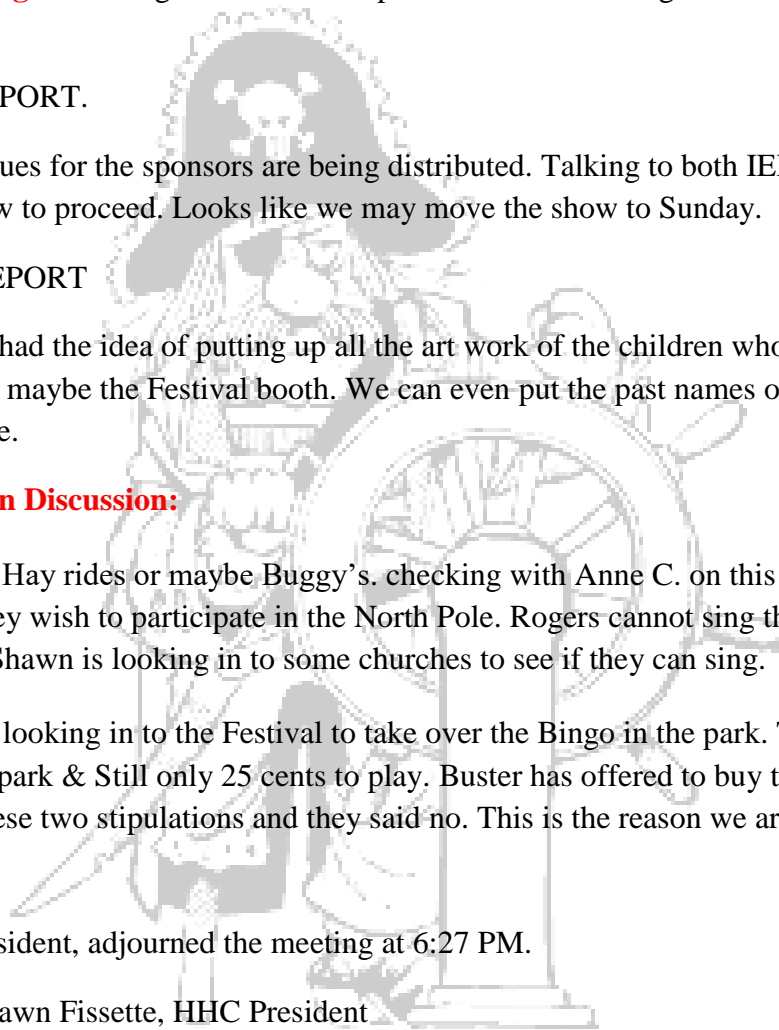
